Dead Tree Removal Operation in Esek Hopkins Park West of Battey Meeting House Road

Who: Small woods operator with equipment and trucks

What: Felling/removal of dead trees killed by spongy (gypsy) moths

When: Late January through early February, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. daily

Where: Wooded portion of Esek Hopkins Park near picnic grove west of Battey Meeting House Road just south of Danielson Pike

Why: To remove about 60 dead trees in danger of falling on hikers and to open short hiking trail with minimal disruption to wildlife and human neighbors

***Not impacted are the playground, softball field,
and trails east of Battey Meeting House Road.***
