

Westconnaug Meadows Amphibian Walk



WHERE: Westconnaug Meadows

WHEN: Saturday April 9, 2016 at 9:00 a.m.

Join the Scituate Conservation Commission and Land Trust members for a walk at Westconnaug Meadows. Along the way members will discuss special features on the landscape and explore amphibians that are found in Rhode Island. We will also take a look at a special wetland found on the property that is used by various amphibian species. The walk is 1.25 miles and will take approximately 1.5 hours. This walk is open to all ages. While dogs on leashes are allowed on the property, we ask that you do not bring them on the day of the walk as we are going to try to listen for frog activity. Please remember to wear sturdy shoes. See you there!

Directions: Westconnaug Meadows is located in the Clayville area of Scituate. From Crazy Corners (junction of Rt 102, 14 and Rockland Road), take Rt 102/14 north towards Foster. Take 3rd left onto Field Hill Road. Once on Field Hill Road, take first right onto George Washington Highway. The parking area will be on the left where the baseball field is located.
